Thank you for entrusting Overbrook School for the Blind (OSB) to be responsible stewards of your generosity. We promise to honor your rights as a donor to our organization as noted in the Donor Bill of Rights.

- I. The right to be informed of our mission, the way we intend to use donated resources, and our capacity to use donations effectively for its intended purposes.
- II. The right to know the identity of those serving on our governing board and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- III. The right to have access to our most recent financial statements.
- IV. The right to be assured that we will use your gifts for the purpose for which they were intended.
- V. The right to receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition of all gifts.
- VI. The right to be assured that information about our donations is handled with respect and confidentiality to the extent required by law.
- VII. The right to expect that all relationships with us will be professional in nature.
- VIII. The right to be informed whether we use volunteers, employees or hired solicitors to seek donations.
- IX. The right to have your name removed from our mailing list.
- X. The right to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
